\*6.e.(2).(d) The Authorized Officer will determine the appropriate designation of a Development Area in terms of location, shape, and size. In most cases, a single Drilling Island will be established for each Development Area. In establishing the location, shape, and size of a Development Area and an associated Drilling Island, the Authorized Officer will consider:

- 6.e.(2).(d).(i) the appropriate location, shape, and size of a Development Area and associated Drilling Island to allow effective extraction of oil and gas resources while managing the impact on potash resources;
- 6.e.(2).(d).(ii) the application of available oil and gas drilling and production technology in the Permian Basin;
- 6.e.(2).(d).(iii) the applicable geology of the Designated Potash Area and optimal locations to minimize loss of potash ore while considering co-development of both resources;
- 6.e.(2).(d).(iv) any long term exploration and/or mining plans provided by the potash industry;
- 6.e.(2).(d).(v) whether a Barren Area may be the most appropriate area for a Drilling Island;
- 6.e.(2).(d).(vi) the requirements of this Order; and
- 6.e.(2).(d).(vii) any other relevant factors.
