To: All Oil & Gas Producers with Active Wellheads in New Mexico

Re: Oil & Gas One Page Bullet Reference Sheet

- All Electrical work in NM shall be performed by Journeyman certified for the voltage and systems being worked on
- All Contracted Electrical work shall be performed by Licensed Electrical Contractors, licensed in New Mexico for the voltage and systems worked on
- All Contracted Electrical work in NM is required to be permitted and inspected. Work performed by employees of oil companies are exempt from permitting
- All Electrical installations shall meet applicable NMEC, NEC, NESC codes
- Provide CID with a list of Electrical Contractors working on your well sites by well sites they worked on that remain from 1-1-2011 and remain active today
- Provide CID with the Systems that the Electrical Contractors worked on at each well site they worked on that remain from 1-1-2011 and remain active today
- Provide CID with the well site name and GPS coordinates drilled from 1-1-2011 and remain active today
