






#### Scientist predicts African icecap's demise due to global warming

By DAVID DERBYSHIRE

SAN FRANCISCO - The icecap of Mount Kilimanjaro one of the most famous landmarks of Africa, will have melted within 20 years because of global warm-

on the Tanzanian mountain has disappeared in the past 12 years. Since it was first mapped in 1912, 82 per cent has been lost.

"At this rate, all of the ice will be gone between 2010 and 2020," said Lonnie Thompson, a geologist at Ohio State University. At least one third of the icefield "And that is probably a conserva-

UNITED NATIONS (AP) \_ A senior U.N. environmental official says entire nations could be wiped off the face of the Earth by rising sea levels if the global warming trend is not reversed by the year 2000.

Coastal flooding and crop failures would create an exodus of "eco-refugees," threatening political chaos, said Noel Brown, director of the New York office of the U.N. Environment Program, or UNEP.




#### GOODBYE TO THE GLACIERS


