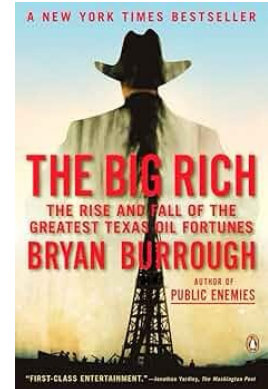

His bestselling book *The Big Rich: The Rise and Fall of the Greatest Texas Oil Fortunes* explores the history of major Texas oil dynasties. The book chronicles the story of four Texas oil tycoons—Roy Cullen, H.L. Hunt, Clint Murchison, and Sid Richardson. Known as the "Big Four," these men amassed immense fortunes, built lasting dynasties, and heavily influenced American politics by bankrolling the rise of modern conservatism. Their stories are certain to both entertain and resonate with independent producers, as the industry evolves with the shale revolution!

- In addition to *The Big Rich*, Mr. Burrough is the author and/or coauthor of seven other books, three others were also New York Times bestsellers, including the Wall Street classic "Barbarians at the Gate" and "Forget the Alamo: The Rise and Fall of an American Myth." A longtime correspondent at *Vanity Fair* and now editor at large at *Texas Monthly*, he lives in Austin.

The premise that humans and nature cannot co-exist, whereby humankind encroaches on wildlife is simply untrue. When the Alaskan pipeline was being built, environmentalists feared the fate of the caribou saying the animals would suffer immensely. The exact opposite happened. The number of caribou has quintupled since production began in early 1978. The equipment provided windbreak, warmth, and shelter.

In 2004, IPANM created a contest where oilfield workers and others could win cash prizes for the best photo or video demonstrating wildlife adapting to manmade changes in their environment.
