The premise that humans and nature cannot co-exist, whereby humankind encroaches on wildlife is simply untrue. When the Alaskan pipeline was being built, environmentalists feared the fate of the caribou saying the animals would suffer immensely. The exact opposite happened. The number of caribou has quintupled since production began in early 1978. The equipment provided windbreak, warmth, and shelter.

In 2004, IPANM created a contest where oilfield workers and others could win cash prizes for the best photo or video demonstrating wildlife adapting to manmade changes in their environment.
